International Executive MBA Cohorts

BMI EMBA Class XIV

which began studies in 2012 and finished in 2014, included 49 executives, of whom 85% were top-level or senior executives at enrolment and 31% were women. More than a third of the cohorts members are business owners. Some of their organisations are MARS, Philip Morris, EY, Xerox, Statoil, JTI, KPMG, KRKA, Danske Bank, PKN Orlen, Maxis, Pieno Žvaigždės, Švyturys-Utenos Alus, Sorainen, LAWIN, Omnitel, TEO LT and Lietuvos Rytas.

BMI EMBA Class XV

which began studies in 2013 and will finish in 2015, includes 50 participants from France, Lebanon, Latvia, Belarus and Lithuania. IT and business services overtook finance as the most represented industries in the class, and manufacturing jumped to a record. More than a third of participants run their own businesses, and the share of women executives rose to 37%. Their average age at enrolment was 34, with an average 12 years of experience. Some of the companies they help manage are Statoil, GlaxoSmithKline, JTI, AC Nielsen, EY Swedbank, Švyturys-Utenos Alus, Delfi, Tieto, Itella and Baltisches Haus.

BMI EMBA Class XVI

began studies in late 2014 and includes 47 executives, of whom 78% are top-level or senior executives. The rest are high-potential mid-level managers from large corporations, lawyers and consulting professionals. With an average age of 34, they manage companies with 15,000 employees, total annual revenues of 3.2 billion euros and 387 million euros of profit. Many members of the cohort work for global business organizations such as Microsoft, Philip Morris, Statoil, Roche, EY, JTI and Hilti. Others help run some of the Nordic-Baltic region’s best-known businesses, including Nordea, TEO LT, LAWIN, PZU, Blue Bridge and Danske Bank.

APRIL:

New BMI Cohort Initiated

The 'Christening Party' for BMI EMBA Class XV was organized by members of Class XIV. The event consisted of an orientation competition followed by a variety of interactive team challenges and a pleasant evening of networking.

Business Lighthouse Awards

Two more members of the BMI family were recognized as among Lithuania's brightest business stars during the annual Business Lighthouse awards ceremony at Vilnius Old City Hall. Arūnas Babrauskas, CEO at Mediafon and member of BMI International Executive MBA Class XIV, received the award for Innovator of the Year, while Arminta Saladžienė, Head of Baltic Market at Nasdaq OMX Group and a 2009 BMI EMBA graduate, won the main award as Business Lighthouse of the Year.



MAY:

EMBA Module at Shanghai Jiao Tong University's Antai College of Economics and Management

Members of EMBA Class XV successfully completed the Project Management Programme at Shanghai Jiao Tong University's Antai College of Economics and Management, one of China's best-ranking business schools. The programme took place together with a week of company visits and cultural immersion in Shanghai, plus expert lectures on the specifics of doing business in China. Moreover, networking events were held with Chinese managers and with China-based alumni of BMI partner school HEC Paris.



JUNE:

HEC Dean Greet 2014 Graduates

The 47 high-level managers who this year graduated from the BMI EMBA received a special greeting from Dean Bernard Ramanantsoa of HEC Paris, Europe's No. 1 business school according to the Financial Times and a founding partner of BMI. "HEC is proud of the long-lasting success of the Baltic Management Institute. I have followed the steady progress of your institution and its rise in the international rankings, due to the quality of content, the excellence of its international faculty and, without a doubt, its meticulous management," Dean Ramanantsoa said in his message. "I wish the Class XIV graduates, and all the distinguished members of the BMI community, the greatest success," he concluded. Three graduates received special awards for achievements. Vitalija Kanevišienė, Financial Manager at JTI Baltic, won the award for the highest grade average. The award for the best EMBA diploma paper went to Karolina Vozgirdaitė, Brand Manager at Phillip Morris Baltic, and the special HEC Paris award for the best thesis in the area of strategy went to Vladimir Gladkikh, Chief Operational Officer at Sberbank-Technology.

Initiative to Beautify Vilnius

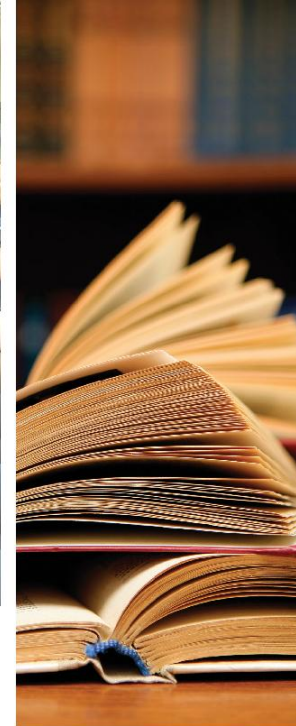

Global Responsibility Initiative

BMI became a signatory to the United Nations initiative on Principles for Responsible Management Education, the first organised relationship between the UN and leading business schools around the world. That's reflected in the design of our International Executive MBA and other programmes."

Lecturer: Dominique R. Jolly (France)

Training focus: Effective business and corporate strategy
Issues addressed: Finding balance between what a company can control and the forces in its competitive environment; the strategy process; determining key success factors; strategic business unit diagnosis and development; in-house development, M&A and inter-firm alliances; the future of diversified groups.

US Natural Strengths and Effective Team Leading (18-19 February)

Lecturer: Kerry Secrest (United States)

Training focus: Personal and team leadership skills

BMI ENCOUNTER 2014: Evolving Opportunities in the Business of Technology

More than 100 business leaders joined this high-level BMI event featuring keynote speaker Mr. Leo Sun, president for Europe at Huawei Technologies, one of the world's biggest and most innovative telecom infrastructure companies. Managers in the ICT sector need to use their imagination and invest heavily and constantly in research and development if they do not want to fall behind, because change in this business is rapid and powerful, like a tsunami, Leo Sun said. Huawei's own vision is "to create a pipe where you can contain the digital tsunami and move the Pacific Ocean from one side of the world to the other in one second," he added. Other experts who shared insights on the future of information and communication technologies were Mr. Dan Stromberg, President of Omnitel, Mr. Remigijus Štaras, the Chairman of App Camp, and Mr. Justinas Pagirys of Invest Lithuania.

"BMI Presents..." Business Safety in Eastern Markets (MAY 6)

Speaker: Inga Martinkutė, LAWIN

Legal tools for reducing business risks were the topic of this lecture and discussion led by a specialist in international investment law. East European markets such as Belarus, Ukraine and Russia can be lucrative places to grow your business, Ms Martinkutė said. But there are also specific political and other risks that may impact your ability to repatriate investments and profits. She presented simple yet little known legal tools for reducing such risks. The key lies in an existing network of international treaties that you can tap for access to more favourable treatment and investment-protection guarantees, Ms Martinkutė noted.

NEW: ALUMNI UPGRADE SESSIONS

BMI during 2014 began offering graduates a chance to upgrade some of the valuable practical knowledge they got in the BMI International Executive MBA programme, and also to network. Alumni Upgrade sessions take place roughly every 6 months and are open to all EMBA graduates, from class 1 to the most recent alumni class. They are free of charge. Two sessions were held during the year.

Financial Policy: Debt & Equity Mix

(February 26)

Lecturer: Professor H. Joel Bessis (France)

The session by one of BMI's top international professors served as a review of the field of corporate finance, focusing on the choice of financial instruments such as debt and equity in order to maximize the value of the firm. The review of financial decision-making centred on analysis of a case study. "The link between strategy and financial performance has become more crucial than ever. It is the responsibility of every general manager to develop an understanding of the way a company's strategic decisions and operating activities affect its financial performance and its ultimate value," Prof. Bessis said.

Executive Presence and Communication Skills

(November 11)

Lecturer: Amy Carroll (Switzerland)

This practical session by one of the most popular lecturers in the BMI EMBA programme gave participants new insights on key aspects of interpersonal relations and public speaking. The presentation was based on the Predator, Prey or Partner™ communication model, which helps managers become more effective, inspiring, engaging leaders.

BMI KNOWLEDGE

Under the BMI Knowledge initiative, BMI publishes executive summaries of research with practical value by faculty members in BMI's international network of management educators. Some of the brief reports also focus on analysis of business trends by industry leaders and policymakers. In this way BMI promotes the creation and sharing of intellectual capital among academic and business leaders.

Crisis Management Discussion Event

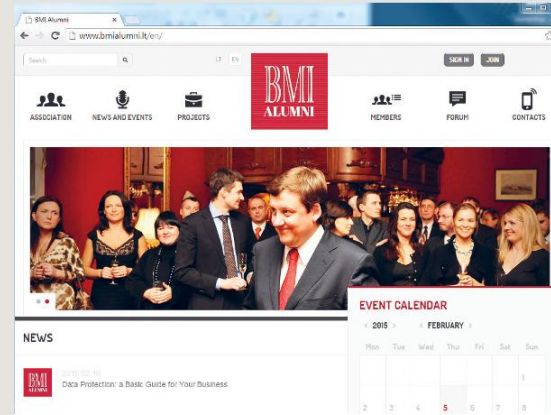
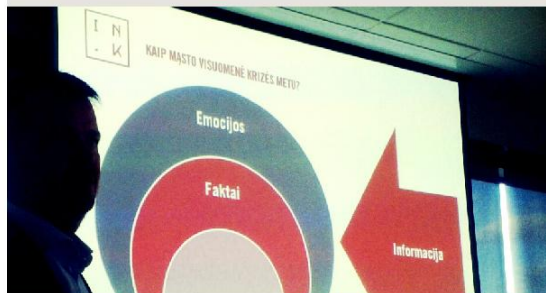
Restaurant "Food", Vilnius (11 April)
