International accreditors in 2015 reaffirmed the leading quality of BMI's International Executive MBA: the European Foundation for Management Development (EFMD) renewed full 5-year EPAS accreditation. The BMI programme thus remains the only one in the CEE and Nordic regions to have earned this exclusive quality label. Now we're working to stay ahead of advances in management education, for instance, by adding more IT content and innovative learning technologies.

Meanwhile, a survey showed our 2015 graduates were the most-satisfied ever. BMI partners launched EMBA with the primary purpose to enhance executive leadership skills of managers in the region who would be equipped with the modern European management skills and tools. In 2009, BMI EMBA curriculum was supplanted with the Asian management perspective and its module delivery distance was expanded by 8000 kilometres. Since then, BMI EMBA students take a module at Shanghai Jiao Tong University in China, the most vibrant economy in the world.

BMI's acknowledgement as a most unique international EMBA provider due to its curriculum excellence, faculty expertise level and diversity allowed us to go beyond the current module set-up in Europe and Asia.

An agreement with Tulane University Freeman School of Business in New Orleans added an Executive MBA module in the USA in 2015. New international partnership creates more global learning and networking opportunities with the executives and businesses in North and South America.

In 2015, BMI launched its Student Global Mobility Scheme on the exchange of executive students with top business schools in Warsaw, Poland and St. Petersburg, Russia. This has opened new doors for our students and raised the share of foreign managers in our EMBA courses to as high as 38%, including participants from Russia, Belarus, Poland, Switzerland and Germany.

Meanwhile, we've followed with pride the advances of BMI alumni, who now lead companies with a combined 52 billion euros of annual revenue.

Every year more than 400 executives in the broader Baltic region, including Belarus, continue to benefit from BMI Executive Education programmes including open seminars, in-company trainings and conferences led by our international professors, Alumni and students. BMI is proud to expand its executive faculty offering by some 5 new international professors every year.

In 2015 BMI and its founding partner school HEC Paris launched a new initiative to promote PhD studies and faculty development in the Baltic region. The newly established BMI fund opens opportunities for BMI EMBA Alumni motivated by academic careers and ambitious junior academics to take one year study at HEC Paris PhD programme. An international selection process was conducted early last year and the newly established BMI Fund awarded its first annual scholarship to a talented PhD student from Lithuania who is now enrolled in HEC Paris' PhD Programme. This is a great example of BMI's broader contribution to management education which we can all be proud of!

## XV

**BMI EMBA Class XV** which began studies in 2013 and finished in 2015, included 50 participants from Lebanon, Latvia, Belarus and Lithuania. IT and business services, finance and manufacturing were the most represented industries in the class, and the share of women executives was 37%. More than a third of participants run their own businesses. The average age at enrolment was 34, with an average 12 years of experience. Some companies they help manage are Statoil, GlaxoSmithKline, JTI, AC Nielsen, EY, Swedbank, Švyturys-Utenos Alus, Delfi, Tieto, Itella. Selected group of executives in the class pioneered at the **USA "Human Resources and Leadership Module"** with executives from the USA and Chile EMBA programmes at **Freeman Business School of Tulane University in New Orleans**.

## XVI

**BMI EMBA Class XVI** began studies in late 2014, will finish in 2016 and includes executives of whom 78% are top-level or senior executives. With an average age of 34, they manage companies with 15,000 employees, **combined annual revenues of 3.2 billion euros** and 387 million euros of profit. Many members of the cohort work for global business organizations such as Microsoft, Philip Morris, Statoil, Roche, EY, JTI and Hilti. Others help run some of the Nordic-Baltic region's best-known businesses, including Nordea, TEQ LT, Valiunas Ellex, PZU, Blue Bridge and Danske Bank.

## XVII

**BMI EMBA Class XVII** began studies in late 2015 and includes business executives and owners from Lithuania, Belarus, Latvia and Russia. It is the most senior class yet at BMI in terms of both management level - **90% are top managers and business owners** and experience - average 13 years. The most highly represented industries are ITT, finance, trade and logistics, followed by media, energy and pharmaceuticals. The group has a combined social network with more than 19,200 managers. They help run companies with annual revenues of about 3.75 billion euros.

### JANUARY

#### Top U.S. School Welcomes BMI Students

Several BMI students joined a module with managers from around the world at Tulane University's Freeman School of Business in New Orleans. BMI's mobility scheme allowed them to complete EMBA courses on Managing People Internationally and Leadership at this high-rated U.S. institution.

### MARCH

#### BMI Gets Full EPAS Accreditation

The EFMD extended EPAS accreditation of BMI's International EMBA for the maximum 5 years after international experts confirmed its strong academic rigour, international identity, corporate relevance, quality assurance and illustrious alumni. BMI's EMBA is the only programme in the CEE and Nordic regions with full 5-year EPAS accreditation.

#### PhD Programme Starts with HEC Paris

BMI signed a cooperation agreement with HEC Paris to promote the training of talented young academics in the Baltic region. A new BMI Fund will award an annual scholarship for PhD studies at HEC Paris, which is a co-founder of BMI and a leading European business school. The goal is to support the training of Baltic-based management faculty and researchers.





## APRIL

### New Cohort Initiated with Music Awards

The 'Christening Party' for BMI EMBA Class XVI was organized by members of Class XV. The event took the form of Music Awards. First, teams of new students were challenged to create amazing music videos. This was followed by an awards ceremony and a pleasant reception in central Vilnius.



## MAY

### MOU with St. Petersburg GSOM

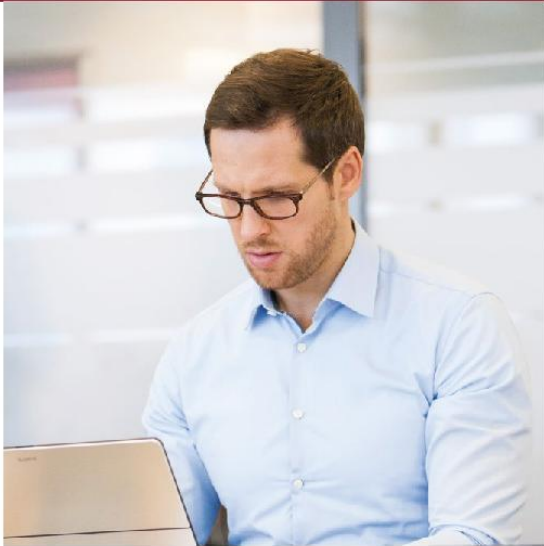

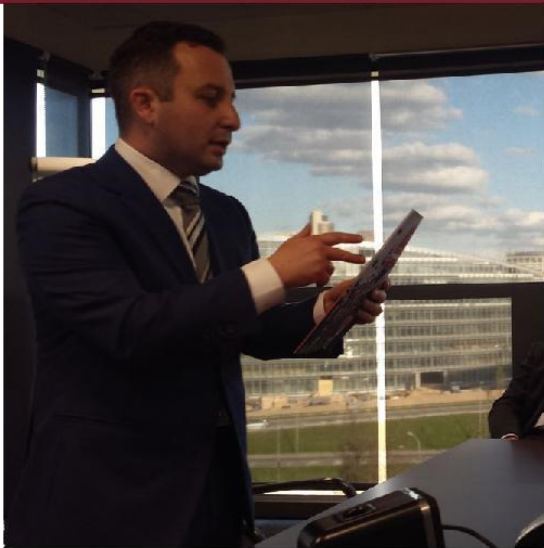

### Wisdom from Millenniums of Jewish Heritage

**Danske Bank, Vilnius (29 April)**

Jewish history and culture were in focus at this gathering – a lively lecture and discussion led by Simonas Gurevičius, executive director of the Jewish Community in Lithuania. 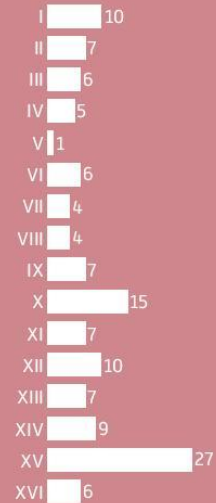
