BMI's Global Mobility Scheme continues to provide increasing value in terms of enriching the learning and networking experience for our programmes' executive participants and alumni.

During 2018, a total of 41 executive participants from other leading business schools around the world came to BMI to attend modules, and 31 BMI participants attended modules abroad across the current 11 offered global module venues. That's in addition to the China module, which all BMI EMBA students attend, and which the current cohort called "essential" after going there in May.

All these exchanges, like the regular international participants in BMI's programmes, give managers new cross-cultural skills and a network of colleagues from all over the world, which is very valuable to today's international business environment.

In 2018, the percentage of international students participating in BMI lectures, case studies, and project work was more than 50%.

For two decades, BMI has been accompanying more than 6000 executives from 35+ countries in their leadership development journey, helping them better understand their role, test their boundaries and lay the foundations for long-term effectiveness. We have followed with pride the advances of BMI Alumni, who now lead companies with a combined 88+ billion euros of annual revenue.

BMI now functions on four continents – North America, South America, Europe, Asia – as a partnership of top international business schools.

Currently BMI programmes include the outstanding "BMI 4-Continent Executive MBA" with 100 % international faculty from 14 leading business schools worldwide, delivered in 11 venues across 4 continents, counting 750+ Alumni & students, "Impactful Leadership & Corporate Finance" Programme taught by the leading professors from Thunderbird Business School and DePaul University in the US and "Innovation & Digital Transformation" Programme delivered in Frankfurt and Vilnius.

In 2018, we continued to develop our strong education offerings for executives. During the year, a third cohort completed the five-month BMI Impactful Leadership & Corporate Finance programme, which now has a total of 112 accomplished alumni.

In the fall of 2018, we launched a new "Innovation & Digital Transformation Programme" to enhance management skills in the new corporate reality of digital transformation focussing around new business models, service & product innovation, AI, internet of things, Industrie 4.0, robotics. The first cohort includes 26 experienced executives representing six countries.

The key factors behind BMI's uniqueness – the quality of the executive participants we attract and our outstanding international faculty – remained quite strong in 2018.

It was a great pleasure to welcome the new EMBA Class XX in November with 45 members, of whom 91% are top or senior-level managers and 33% are women. They boast between 8 and 20 years of management experience, while 47% hold a previous master's degree and a few even have a doctorate. Interestingly, almost 20% of the new cohort work in manufacturing industry, which for the first time is the largest representation in a BMI EMBA class.

During the past year, BMI also welcomed two new faculty members. One is Keith Goffin, Professor of Innovation and New Product Development at Cranfield School of Management. The second is Joe Peppard, who leads research and teaches in IT leadership, digital strategy and innovation management at MIT Sloan School of Management and lectures internationally.

As a modern tool to support teaching and learning at BMI, we have recently launched a new e-learning platform and intranet for the school. The initial version is now being fine-tuned. The platform offers great facilities for the continual development of new and valuable features for BMI students, faculty members and alumni. Stay tuned for more news about that.

BMI 4-CONTINENT EXECUTIVE MBA PROGRAMME

The BMI 4-Continent Executive MBA is a unique programme for high-level managers and business owners designed by top business schools worldwide and delivered in North and South America, Europe and Asia.

BMI EMBA Class XVIII

graduated in 2018. It includes 45 executives, of whom **91% are top-level and senior executives** and many are business owners. They have an average age of 36, an average 14 years of experience and international exposure encompassing 58 countries. Among the numerous industries represented in the group, executives from ITT, finance and trade have the biggest presence, followed by manufacturing, energy and logistics. Some cohort members work with global organizations like CSC, AIG, JTI, Tikkurila, Circle K, Avon Cosmetics and Deloitte. Others help run top Nordic-Baltic businesses such as ATEA, Telia, Ellex Valiunas, Euroapotecha and Danske Bank.



BMI EMBA Class XIX,

which began studies in the second half of 2017 after an especially rigorous admissions process, includes **50 executives from Lithuania, Latvia, Estonia and Switzerland**. With an average age of 37 and up to 20 years of management experience, 90% are top-level and senior executives. Not only do all the members of this class have a university degree, but 50% already hold a master's degree and 10% boast a PhD. Executives from industries like finance, ITT, and trade have the biggest presence in the cohort, followed by representatives of the legal profession and manufacturing.

BMI EMBA Class XX

was formed in late 2018 and has 45 experienced executives from Lithuania, France, Russia and Ukraine. This **anniversary BMI cohort** is unique in that, for the first time in BMI's now 20 years of history, it is **dominated by high-level managers from the manufacturing industry**, who make up nearly 20% of the class. For them, technological advancement and managerial excellence go hand in hand as core business success factors. Overall, executive participants in the new group represent companies with 46.4 billion euros of combined revenue and 111 000 employees worldwide.



IMPACTFUL LEADERSHIP & CORPORATE FINANCE PROGRAMME

May - September 2018

In order to generate competitive value, successful executives should be aware of themselves, able to lead and coach their teams with a leadership style that is appropriate for each situation, work effectively with diverse types of business counterparts, and excel in financial skills. This three-module programme approaches leadership, impactful negotiations and finance as a process and lets managers develop skills to lead effectively in their current roles and throughout their careers, making financially sound and commercially viable decisions. Rated 91% for overall quality by 3 BMI cohorts.

Credits earned in the programme can later be transferred to the BMI 4-Continent Executive MBA.

This module enables participants to secure a comprehensive approach to successful negotiations, equipping them with tools that are indispensable to master.

Today digital transformation along with product, service and business model innovation are driving forces of corporate growth. To become a digital leader, organizations need to develop a digital business agility that combines hyperawareness, informed decision-making and fast implementation.

THE NETWORK CODE

(2 March)

SPEAKER: Mark Patterson, Founder of the Network Academy

This session with an international business networking expert who is an adjunct member of the BMI Executive Education faculty offered the gathered business leaders a deeper understanding of the nature and mechanics of networking, with tips on how to kick-start one's network. One common mistake that many people make, he noted, is networking mainly when it's "urgent and important". Much more effective is making connections with people when it's not urgent, when you don't need anything from them and aren't trying to sell them anything, he stressed. Those tend to be very positive contacts who can have big value for you over the longer term.



SOURCES OF THE NEXT CRISIS

(6 June)

SPEAKER: Žygimantas Mauricas, Chief Economist at Luminor Bank

Dr. Mauricas, who is an alumnus of the BMI EMBA Class XVI, spoke with executives about long-term factors that influence historical economic development and short-term business cycles, with analysis of where the Baltic and global economies currently stand. According to Dr Mauricas, forecasts suggest that in the current cycle growth has already peaked. Details discussed during the session included the significance of Brexit, China's economic slowdown, potential global trade wars and growing interest rate differentials, and – in the Baltic region – prospects for the currently hot real estate sector.



FAST GROWTH IN TRANSPORT

(3 October)

SPEAKER: Rokas Masiulis, Minister of Transport and Communications of the Republic of Lithuania

Lithuania's Minister for Transport outlined how the country's transport sector is presently growing at record speed. It is doing so amid several major challenging projects, including Rail Baltica, Via Baltica and the expansion of the Klaipėda port. In that context of growth, and looking ahead to the relatively near future, investments in digitalisation and preparations for the introduction of artificial intelligence in the transport sector are extremely important, the Minister stressed.



ALUMNI UPGRADE SESSION

PLOTTING THE ECONOMIC COURSE FOR 2019

(14 December)

SPEAKER: Andrius Škarnulis, Head of Macroeconomics and Forecasting, Bank of Lithuania

BMI regularly offers its graduates a chance to upgrade some of the valuable practical knowledge they got in the 4-Continent Executive MBA or certificate programmes, and also to network. Alumni Upgrade sessions are open exclusively to graduates of its programmes. During this session Andrius Škarnulis, a central bank official who is also a member of BMI EMBA Class XIX, performed an insightful economic analysis together with the participating alumni, examining the health of the Lithuanian economy, the long-term trends that are most affecting business in this geographic region, and current key trends in the global economy. The focus throughout the session was on what to expect from the local and international economy during the coming year.

JANUARY

International Week in the USA

A USA module took 10 European members of BMI EMBA Class XVIII to Tulane University's Freeman School of Business in the city of New Orleans. There, together with other executive students from the USA and Latin America, they joined Tulane's Executive MBA International Week Program.

The experience had a strong HR focus, with courses on Managing People Internationally and Leadership & Ethics. It included lectures, cases, projects and informal interactions. "Great professors, an amazing multicultural environment, and loads of a-ha! moments and discoveries," is how Amelija Rudenko, General Manager at UAB Kapitel and one of the BMI participants, summarized the module.

Irish professor teams up with bank economist

Much admired by BMI executives for his drive and insight, Prof. Eamonn Walsh of University College Dublin for this year's EMBA course on the Global Economic Environment brought in guest speaker Dr. Žygimantas Mauricas, the chief economist at Luminor Bank. Dr. Mauricas offered his thoughts on why some economies develop faster than others, the significance of Brexit, slowdown in Chinese growth, and potential global trade wars, among other key issues.

Awards for special achievements were also presented to several of the new graduates.

Innovation & Digital Transformation programme launched

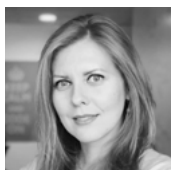
